EDUCATION GRANTS SCHEME

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE GARDENS TRUST can distribute up to £100 per annum to help in the enhancement of the gardens of educational establishments in Northamptonshire. This will generally be for hard landscape features, tree planting, tree clearance, tree surgery, etc. Grants may also be used for equipment and for setting-up school gardening clubs, or for staff attendance at appropriate Royal Horticultural Society training days.

The maximum single grant will be £100 and not more than 50% of the total cost of a project will be given.

Applications will be considered by the Trust at their quarterly meetings. A member of the NORTHAMPTONSHIRE GARDENS TRUST Committee will visit the garden before any grant is determined. Any grant will then be paid on completion of the project for which it is given and after approval by the Trust's representative.

The recipient must notify the Trust on completion of the project. A grant must be claimed within twelve months of the date of its approval.

The Trust would be glad to receive a description of the completed project, possibly with photographs, which could be published in the Trust's newsletter.
